How Can Lifespan Respite Care Support Your Family?

A respite break can reduce feelings of isolation, provide opportunities to socialize, participate in community activities, and pursue interests as individuals and as a family. Most importantly, respite enhances the health and well-being of caregivers, increasing the ability of families to continue in-home care for their loved ones.

Who Provides Respite Care?

Lifespan Respite Care providers are individuals or agencies who provide respite care either in the home or in a center-based facility. Lifespan Respite Care compiles a registry of these caregivers and helps match them with your specific needs.

Each individual care provider is subject to both criminal background and personal reference checks which are updated every two years.

Depending on their skills and abilities, some providers work with children while others work with adults or the elderly. Some are certified nursing assistants or home aides, and others have gained experience by caring for their own family member.
