helpful tool when trying to acknowledge and move past loss. The acronym S.E.L.F stands for safety, emotion management, loss and future. The model helps facilitate important dialogue that will guide you through big changes in your life. Recognizing and sitting with the vulnerabilities and emotions that come with loss are vital steps in the process of grieving so that you may focus on moving forward to what lies ahead.

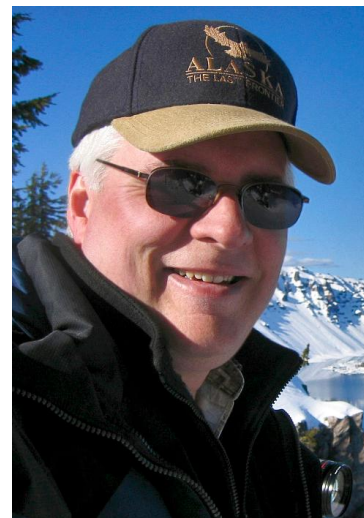


Welcome Ben Carlson, Our New "Safety Guy"
